



#### Day 1 March 7, Thursday: Welcome to Panama!

Depart Chicago O'Hare International Airport for our flight to Panama City. Complimentary beverages will be served in flight. Arrive at Panama City Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and a Peter's Way Tour Manager will meet us as we exit from Customs. Board our comfortable motor coach and enjoy an orientation tour of this modern city, also known as the capital of Panama. Panama City is the largest city of Panama with over 1.5 million people in its metropolitan area. The city is the political and administrative center of the country, as well as a hub for banking and commerce. Check-in at Las Americas Golden Tower hotel. Independent dinner.

Overnight Las Americas Golden Tower hotel.

### Day 2 March 8, Friday: City Tour | Panama Canal | Evening

Breakfast at the hotel. Board our motor coach for a panoramic city tour. En route to the Panama Canal, we will see Casco Antiguo, Causeway of Amador, preserved American military centers, Hospitals, Universities and Canal buildings. Arrive at the Panama Canal. The Panama Canal, Canal de Panamá, is an artificial 48-mile waterway in Panama that connects the Atlantic Ocean with the Pacific Ocean. The canal cuts across the Isthmus of Panama and is a conduit for maritime trade. It takes 11+ hours to pass through the Panama Canal and The American Society of Civil Engineers has named the Panama Canal one of the seven wonders of the modern world. We will have the opportunity to see ships crossing the canal and visit the local Museum. Following our museum visit, we will enjoy lunch at Mi Ranchito restaurant. Return to hotel to freshen-up. Evening sung Mass followed by 30-minute concert. (Location TBD) Independent dinner. Overnight at Las Americas Golden Tower hotel. (B,L)

#### Day 3 March 9, Saturday: Embera Village

Breakfast at the hotel. The morning, board our motor coach for the 2-hour journey to Embera Village. The people of the village of Embera migrated about 50 years ago, seeking a better quality of life for themselves and their children. They have lived in this area for centuries, long before there were countries called Panamá and Colombia, and before the first Spanish explorer set foot in the new world. They settled in what is now the Chagres National Park and are within 1-2 hours from a city with modern medicine, supplies and secondary education for the children. Our culturally immersive visit will include traditional dances, music, songs and the opportunity to learn about their natural medicine - made from local resources. After spending time with the tribe, we will enjoy a typical Embera-style lunch including plantains, fresh fish and fruit. Return to our hotel to freshen-up before dinner. Dinner tonight will be at Las Tinajas Restaurant. Our meal will include typical Panamanian food complemented by a folkloric dancing show. (B,L,D)Overnight at Las Americas Golden Tower hotel.

#### Day 4 March 10, Sunday: Walking Tour of the Old Town Evening Sung Mass and Concert at Nuestra Señora de **Guadalupe Church**

Breakfast at the hotel. This morning, we will have a waking tour of the Old Town where you can observe the various architectural styles that demonstrates the rich cultural heritage of the area. The main styles are: Spanish, because Panama was a Spanish colony; French, due to the fact that French and Italians who made the first at-tempted to construct the canal lived in the area. Over the last few years the Old Town has undergone a massive restoration to bring the buildings, monuments and promenades to their former glory. A must see! Independent lunch. Return to hotel to freshen-up. This evening we will be transferred to Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe Church to attend the 6:00pm. Mass, followed by

#### a Concert presentation by St. Gregory the Great Church Choir. Independent Dinner.

#### Day 5 March 11, Monday: Gamboa Rainforest | Gatun Lake

Breakfast at the hotel. This morning, board our motor coach for our visit to the Gamboa Rainforest. Enjoy a panoramic tour along the world famous Panama Canal. Our trip will take us into the Gatun Lake, a major part of the Panama Canal, where we will see and learn about the fascinating tropical wildlife of the lake and the surrounding forest. We will explore some of the islands formed after the creation of which was once the largest artificial lake in the world. With a little luck and with the help of our nature guide, we hope to see crocodiles, caimans, sloths, monkeys and a host of birds native to the area. (Water and soda included) Enjoy lunch "Los Lagartos" restaurant. Afterwards, return to our hotel to freshen up. Evening sung Mass followed by 30-minute **concert.** (Location TBD)

Overnight at Las Americas Golden Tower hotel.

#### Day 6 March 12, Tuesday: Santa Clara

Breakfast at the hotel. This morning we will be transferred to Santa Clara, to the Sheraton Bijao Beach Resort for check-in. Rest of the day at leisure to enjoy the facilities. Independent lunch.

Dinner and overnight at the Sheraton Bijao Beach Resort. (B,D)

#### Day 7 March 13, Wednesday: El Valle

Breakfast at the hotel. This morning we will be transferred to El Valle to enjoy a day of outdoor activities. When we reach El Valle, we will walk roughly 30 minutes from the center of town to visit El Chorro del Macho. It is the largest waterfall in the region with a drop of 70 meters, and features a natural lagoon. Afterwards, we will visit El Nispero Zoo and Botanical Garden. The Zoo is set in a beautiful backdrop deep in the heart of nature. Walking around the zoo you will find many different animals native to Panama and Latin America. From birds to tapirs, monkeys to horses, Nispero offers a wide variety of interesting animals for you to see up close. The most popular attraction of this zoo is the golden frog. The golden frog is an endangered toad that is not just native to Panama but specifically to the region of El Valle. After our visit to the zoo, we will explore the Thermal Springs, also known as Pozos Thermales. These thermal springs contain many minerals beneficial for circulation. Afterwards, we will enjoy a lunch at Triana restaurant. Return to the hotel. Dinner buffet at Sheraton Bijao Beach

Overnight at the Sheraton Bijao Beach Resort. (B,L,D)

#### Day 8 March 14, Thursday: Full Day at Leisure

Breakfast at the hotel. Today, enjoy a full day at leisure and enjoy the hotel activities. We suggest spending time in the pool and at the beach. Lunch and dinner buffet included. **Evening Prayer Service at the hotel.** Overnight at the Sheraton Bijao Beach Resort. (B,L,D)

#### Day 9 March 15, Friday: Full Day at Leisure

Breakfast at the hotel. Today, enjoy a full day at leisure and enjoy the hotel activities. We suggest spending time in the pool and at the beach. Lunch and dinner buffet included.

Overnight at the Sheraton Bijao Beach Resort. (B,L,D)

#### Day 10 March 16, Saturday: Return to the USA

Leisurely breakfast at the hotel. Late morning, we will be transferred to the airport for our return flight to the USA.

#### Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or debit/credit card. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase package price or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the Balboa valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or debit/credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, there is a \$350.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a nonrefundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments madeper person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplment, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are nonrefundable upon receipt. Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. **IMMUNIZATIONS:** All participants should be up to date on routine vaccinations before traveling. These vaccines include measles-mumps-rubella (MMR) vaccine, diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis vaccine, varicella (chickenpox) vaccine, polio vaccine, and your yearly flu shot. Peter's Way Tours recommends that every traveler consult with their physician prior to traveling.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip economy class on Copa Airlines from Chicago. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. **TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE:** Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing a hotel room with two twin beds with private facilities. Married couples may request a double bed, however, double beds are subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, however, there is no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. If confirmed, an additional charge of \$1,095.00 will apply. We will make every effort to accommodate roommate requests, but we cannot guarantee double occupany. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast daily plus six (6) lunches and five (5) dinners.

**GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES:** Gratuities to the tour manager/guide, and driver are not included in the package price and will be collected prior to departure. \$80 will be added to each participant's final invoice to cover tips for the 10-day choir pilgrimage. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges at the hotels are included, it is customary to leave \$1.00 per person for your waiter following dinner at the hotel and \$1.00 per person per day for housekeeping.
