I invite you to join St. Gregory the Great Parish Choir pilgrimage on an exciting 10-day journey to the "Best of Spain". We will will embark on this trip through Spain including Madrid, Toledo, El Escorial Monastery, Avila, Zaragoza, Montserrat and Barcelona.

We will perform and sing for Masses at the Basilica of San Miguel in Madrid, Santo Tomé in Toledo, El Escorial Monastery, Our Lady of the Pillar in Zaragoza, the Benedictine Monastery of Montserrat, Sagrada Familia and the Cathedral in Barcelona, the Benedictine.

Our musical spiritual journey includes visits to Madrid and Puerta del Sol, the magnificent fountains of Neptune and Cibeles, the stately Alcala Gate, the busy Gran Via, and the Plaza de Espana. Discover El Escorial Monastery, a fascinating sight in the heart of Spain. Our journey will conclude in Avila, during 4th Centenary of St. Teresa of Avila's beatification. Continue on to Zaragoza where tradition holds that Our Lady, while still alive, appeared to St. James. At Barcelona, we visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Montserrat, and Gaudi's Barcelona, including Sagrada Family and the Magnificent Cathedral.

Join us as we discover the beauty and wonders of Spain, while deepening our faith and the bonds of charity with each other. I hope you will consider joining us as pilgrims to these holy and historical places.

Day 1 March 13, Friday: Depart USA

Depart Chicago O'Hare International Airport on our overseas journey when the Iberia Airlines jet lifts into the evening sky on our overnight flight to Madrid. Complimentary meals and beverage will be served aloft. (D,B)

Day 2 March 14, Saturday: Arrive Madrid

Arrive at Madrid International Airport and proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and our Peter's Way Tour Manager/guide will meet us upon our exit from Customs. Our luggage will be transferred to our bus and soon, we will be on our way to Madrid. As our Madrid hotel rooms are unlikely to be ready, we will be taken on an orientation tour of Madrid's most outstanding attractions, like the Puerta del Sol, the magnificent fountains of Neptune and Cibeles, the stately Alcala Gate, the busy Gran Via, the Plaza de Espana. Independent lunch. Check-in at hotel. Balance of the day is at leisure. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Madrid.

Day 3 March 15, Sunday: Prado Museum & the Royal Palace – Evening/Mass at the Basilica of St. Miguel, following by concert

Buffet breakfast at our hotet. Begin our day with a visit to the Prado Museum, justly famous as one of the world's richest for its spectacular collection of paintings including the incomparable works of El Greco, Velásquez, Murillo, Goya and others. And don't forget that, thanks to the extraordinary taste and acquisitiveness of Charles V, Philip II, and Philip IV, the Prado is also rich in the works of Italian and Flemish masters - Titian, Raphael, Botticelli, Fraq Angelico, Veronese, Tintoretto, Rubens, Van Dyck and Breughel, and a fine collection of Bosch Paintings. Continue on to visit the Royal Palace, built for Spain's royalty in the 18th century. (The Royal Palace can be closed unexpectedly for official celebration). King Juan Carlos I and Queen Sophia continue to use it today for many state functions. The surrounding area is one of the most beautiful palatial complexes in all Europe and includes the Plaza de Oriente, the Sabatini Gardens and the Campo del Moro. Independent lunch. Return to the hotel to freshen-up. Early evening, we will be transferred to the Basilica of San Miguel, a surprising 18th century construction, typically Italian Baroque in style, with a convex front embellished with statues. At 7:00pm we will Attend Mass, sung by St. Gregory the Great Parish Choir, followed by 30 minute concert presentation (subject to confirmation).

Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Madrid. (B,I

Day 4 March 16, Monday: Full day excursion to visit Toledo

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, leave on our excursion to visit Toledo. Toledo is like a living national monument, depicting all the elements of Spanish civilization in hand-carved, sun-mellowed stone. Set on a hill overlooking the Tagus River, this ancient city is a fascinating architectural blend of Christian and Moorish elements, especially rich in buildings of the late 15th and 16th centuries. Upon arrival we visit the Jewish Quarter. Without a doubt, it is the eastern part of the Jewish Quarter that attracts most tourists. Pass by Santa Maria La Blanca Synagogue, and the Iglesia de Santo Tomé church, where one of

El Greco's most famous paintings resides, "El Entierro del Conde de Orgaz" (The Burial of the Count of Orgaz). Independent lunch.

Visit the 13th century Cathedral. Somber but elaborate, it is blazing with jeweled chalices, gorgeous ecclesiastical vestments, hundreds of historic tapestries, 750 stained-glass windows and art by Tintoretto, Titian, Murillo, El Greco, Velasquez and Goya. Taking the Travesía de los Descalzos, we reach the Plaza del Conde where the Fuensalida Palace is located. Built by the first Fuensalida Count, Don Pedro López de Ayala, it is today the seat of the Regional Government. Pass by the Paseo de San Cristóbal Boulevard. Vespers, presented by St. Gregory the Great Parish Choir at Santo Tomé Church in Toledo (subject to confirmation). Independent dinner.

Overnight at the hotel in Madrid.

Day 5 March 17, Tuesday: Excursion to El Escorial & Avila

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, leave on our excursion to visit the world famous El Escorial Monastery dating from the 16th century, more properly, San Lorenzo del Escorial, the burial place of Spanish kings and queens. Philip II, as a memorial, built this monastery to his father, Charles V. A vast rectangular building, it was conceived and executed with a monotonous magnificence. The Church itself is in the shape of a Greek cross, and contains a famous cross, created by Benvenuto Cellini. There will be a 15 minute informal recital at El Escorial Monastery presented by St. Gregory the Great Parish Choir (subject to confirmation). Late morning, we continue to Avila, City of Kings and of Saints, completely encircled by 11th Century walls. The city walls are the symbolical emblem of the city. They contribute to the defining image of the warring and monastic center that Avila was and has been able to maintain throughout the years. It constitutes a unique symbol that encloses within its walls mysticism and history, art and heroic chivalry. This is the birthplace of St. Teresa, one of the greatest mystics and Doctor of the Church. Indepenent lunch upon arrival in Avila.

This afternoon, we visit St. Vincent's Church. Erected in the 11th century in honor of its martyr, it is one of the monumental complexes of Avila. Continue to visit the Cathedral. It portrays the eldest transition of the Spanish Gothic, as seen by the reliefs on the walls, which were also part of the city's defenses. Next we pass by the house where she was born nowadays Convent and Museum of Santa Teresa. Independent dinner.

Overnight at the castle in the Parador de Siguenza.

Day 6 March 18, Wednesday: Siguenza - Zaragoza - Evening/Concert Presentation

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, leave Madrid for Zaragoza. Upon arrival we visit the old quarter. One of the great monumental towns in Spain, Zaragoza was founded over 2000 years ago. Still evident in the city are the remains of the Old Iberian, Roman, Gothic and Arabian empires which ruled long ago. Zaragoza presents an impressive landscape with picturesque villages and some of the most important buildings of the Spanish baroque style. Continue on to visit the Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillars, one of the most visited pilgrimage spots in the entire country, because Our Lady visited Zaragoza before her Assumption into Heaven. Tradition holds that Our Lady, while still alive, appeared to St. James at the Ebero River to encourage him in his evange-lization. As a sign of her protection, Mary left him the pillar with her statue. The pillar, which still emits an extraordinary fragrance, can be venerated in the church. Its cupola boasts murals painted by Goya, and the church museum houses a large collection of religious art. There will be a 15 minute informal recital at the Basilica (subject to confirmation). Independent lunch.

Check-in at hotel in Zaragoza. Freshen-up. Late afternoon, we will be transferred to the village of Alfajarín to visit the Parish Church of St. Michael the Archangel (Iglesia parroquial de San Miquel Arcangel). Evening concert presented by St. Gregory the Great Parish Choir (subject to confirmation). Dinner at a restaurant in the village of Alfajarin.

Overnight at the hotel in Zaragoza. (B,D)

Day 7 March 19, Thursday: Zaragoza - Montserrat - Barcelona

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we leave Zaragoza for Barcelona. En-route we stop to visit the Benedictine Abbey of Montserrat. For over a thousand years pilgrims from everywhere in Europe have made their way to the Benedictine Shrine of the Cherished Black Madonna, said to have been carved by St. Luke. Visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Montserrat and the Benedictine Monastery standing 2,379 feet above sea level, surrounded by jagged peaks and massive rock formations that present a fantastic primeval appearance. We will witness the Escolania boy choir singing the Virolai (hymn dedicated to the Virgin of Montserrat) at 12:00pm. There will be a 10 minute offering to Our Lady of Montserrat "recital" at the Abbey of Montserrat sung by St. Gregory the Great Parish Choir (subject to confirmation). Time will be given for reflection and independent lunch. Continue to Barcelona for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Barcelona.

Day 8 March 20, Friday: Parc Guell & Sagrada Familia – Afternoon Panoramic Cruise on the Mediterranean Sea

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a visit to Parc Güell. The intention was to build a garden city of 60 dwellings to demonstrate Gaudi's ideas on town planning. The architect's death reduced the project to the construction of two houses, a few covered walks, a long seat and the park entrance, which includes a mosaic made from everyday materials in brilliant colors. Continue on to the art deco works of native Antonio Gaudi (1852 - 1926), Sagrada Familia (Church of the Holy Family). Due to Gaudi's untimely death, the Church on which he had first started to work in 1884 was left incomplete in 1926. The design was begun in conventional Neo-Gothic. He completed the crypt, the famous Nativity facade with its four tall spires and the porch laden with naturalistic sculpture. The work was restarted in 1940, however, at a great disadvantage. Gaudi had left no plans and no one was able to imitate his free interpretation of Gothic motifs. The Church has become a symbolic monument for Barcelona, visited by more people than any other site. (20 minute recital at Sagrada Familia, presented by St. Gregory the Great Parish Choir (subject to confirmation).

This afternoon, we will be transferred to Barcelona Pier for one-hour panoramic cruise on the Mediterranean. Balance of the day is at leisure. Independent dinner.

Overnight at hotel in Barcelona.

Day 9 March 21, Saturday: AM/Highlight tour of Barcelona Afternoon at leisure - Evening/Sung Vigil Mass at the Cathedral in Barcelona

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a visit to Montjuih Hill, the site of the 1992 Olympics, and enjoy a spectacular view of Barcelona and its port area. Continue to the Gothic Quarter to visit the magnificent Cathedral, the Church of Santa Maria del Mar, the Palau de la Generalitat, the Town Hall, the small streets that lead to the Plaza Real, Avenue Paseo de Garcia, and Las Ramblas. Independent lunch.

Return to our hotel to freshen-up. This evening, we will be transferred to the Cathedral of Barcelona (Holy Cross and Saint Eulalia) for rehearsal: 6:00pm to 6:45pm. 7:00pm, Sung Vigil Mass at the Cathedral by St. Gregory the Great Parish Choir and 30 minute recital (subject to confirmation).

Farewell dinner this evening will be held at a local restaurant.

Overnight at the hotel in Barcelona.

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package (\$2,495.00 per person, sharing a twin bedded room) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the land only package or who are deviaing from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. Additionally, if you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

TRANSFER/PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with private facilities in hotels throughout your tour. Matrimonial (full) bedded rooms are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms are available for family or friends traveling together. We discourage triple room accommodations because they are normally not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or matrimonial (full) bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an additional charge of \$695.00. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be located away from the group. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment

or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated

MEALS: Breakfast daily plus five (5) dinners including a farewell dinner in Barcelona. Beverages (coffee, tea, mineral water) are not included at set menu dinners.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. For good work, recommended (but voluntary) tipping to your tour manager is 4.00 Euro per passenger per day; to the driver is 2.00 Euro per passenger per day; for the local guides 1.50 Euro per passenger per day. Tips for the tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave 1.00 Euro per person for the waiters after each meal and 1.00 Euro per person per day for the maid/bell boys.
