

*Later that evening, the choir will also present a formal concert at the Church of Chiesa Nuova. This performance is one in a series of professionally organized concerts, enjoyed by an audience of approximately three hundred.*

*We also will celebrate Mass with song at the Cathedral in Sorrento, at the Cathedral in Naples, the Franciscan Basilica of the Rosary in Pompeii, and the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls in Rome. We will also perform an informal recital at the Basilica of St. Mary Major and the Cathedral of St. John Lateran in Rome. We hope that you will choose to be a part of this sacred pilgrimage of prayer and song, either as a chorister or an accompanying pilgrim.*

*In addition to visiting Christian Rome, we will also visit Sorrento, Capri, Pompeii, Positano, the Amalfi Coast, and Montecasino.*

*Please join us as we retrace the steps of Peter and Paul, the ancient Romans, the Popes of history, and the throngs of others who have come to see and pray in the Eternal City.*

## **Day 1 March 9, Saturday: Depart U.S.A.**

Today, depart Chicago O'Hare and Philadelphia International Airport via US Airways for your overnight flight to Rome, Italy.

Complimentary meals and beverages will be served aloft.

## **Day 2 March 10, Sunday: Arrive Rome – Sorrento – Evening/Sung Mass**

Upon arrival at Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim your luggage and be greeted and assisted by our Peter's Way Tours tour manager as you exit Customs. Your luggage will be transferred to our motor coach, and you will be on your way as we drive south on the Autostrada del Sol, "Sun Route," via the regions of Lazio and Campania for Sorrento.

Independent lunch en-route.

This afternoon check in at hotel in Sorrento.

Freshen-up. Then, you will be transferred to the Cathedral of St. Filippo and Giacomo in Sorrento for the 6:30pm Mass, sung by St. Gregory the Great Parish Choir.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Sorrento.

## **Day 3 March 11, Monday: Excursion to the Isle of Capri**

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning, from the harbor of Sorrento, we take a scenic fast hydrofoil to the romantic Island of Capri, the highlight of the day. Visit the magical "Blue Grotto" (weather permitting). We arrive at Marina Piccola and ascend by Funicular to Capri Town. Independent lunch and time will be given for shopping, strolling about and enjoying the resort atmosphere of this royal retreat. This afternoon, take the fast hydrofoil back to Sorrento. Balance of the day at leisure. Independent dinner in Capri.

Overnight at hotel in Sorrento.

## **Day 4 March 12, Tuesday: Pompeii & Naples – Evening/Sung Mass**

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning, we leave Sorrento to the near-by town of Pompeii. Upon arrival our local guide will be ready to take us to explore the incredibly well-preserved remains of this ancient Roman town, where all life was suddenly stopped by an eruption of Vesuvius in the year 79 A.D. Pompeii was destroyed, and completely buried, during a long catastrophic eruption of the volcano Mount Vesuvius spanning two days in AD 79. The volcano collapsed higher roof-lines and buried Pompeii under 60 feet of ash and pumice, and it was lost for nearly 1700 years before its accidental rediscovery in 1748. Since then, its excavation has provided an extraordinarily detailed insight into the life of a city at the height of the Roman Empire. Today, it is one of the most popular tourist attractions of Italy. Independent lunch.

This afternoon, we continue to visit Naples. Naples is situated on a beautiful bay on the Mediterranean Coast. Enjoy your panoramic ride of the city: Mergellina, Castel dell'Ovo, Plebiscito Square, The Royal Palace, and the Maschio Angioino with its triumphal arch and deep moats. Enjoy and photograph the famous view of the city, the bay and Mt. Vesuvius. Then, we continue to visit the Cathedral (Duomo di San Gennaro), the blood miracle of St. Januarius. Saint Januarius, the patron of Naples, is famous for the miracle of the annual liquefaction of his blood. People assemble to witness in amazement this event in the cathedral (Duomo di San Gennaro) of Naples three times a year: On September 19 (St. Januarius Day), December 16, and on the Saturday before the first Sunday of May. **Celebrate the evening Mass at the Cathedral in Naples, sung by St. Gregory the Great Parish Choir.**

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Sorrento.

## **Day 5 March 13, Wednesday: Positano & Amalfi – Evening/Formal Concert in Pompeii**

Breakfast at your hotel. Today the group will be split into minibuses for the Amalfi towns. From Sorrento, we take a spectacular drive as we visit the Amalfi town of Positano and Amalfi, where we enjoy a remarkable bird's-eye view of Positano, commanding a beautiful view of the Gulf of Naples. Continue on to the Amalfi town to visit the Cathedral of St. Andrew the Apostle. **20-minute informal recital at the Cathedral of St. Andrew.** Independent lunch and time will be given to browse in the little town of the Amalfi. This afternoon, return to your hotel to freshen-up.

Early dinner at your hotel.

**After dinner, you will be transferred to the Franciscan Basilica of the Rosary in Pompeii for a formal concert presented by St. Gregory the Great Parish Choir.**

Overnight at hotel in Sorrento.

## **Day 6 March 14, Thursday: Excursion to Amalfi Coast**

Breakfast at your hotel. Today the group will be split into minibuses to visit the Amalfi Coast. Our full day excursion include the Amalfi coast and the towns of Ravello, Minori, Maiori, Vietri Sul Mare and Salerno. Independent lunch in one of the towns.

**While in Salerno, we visit the Cathedral of St. Matthew, and present a 20-minute informal recital.**

Dinner at your hotel.

Overnight at hotel in Sorrento.

## **Day 7 March 15, Friday: Sorrento - Montecasino-Mentorella-Rome**

Breakfast at your hotel. Today we leave Sorrento for Rome. En-route we visit Montecasino, the 5th century Abbey and the cradle of the Benedictine Order, where the motherhouse of the Benedictines was founded by St. Benedict in 529 and where the saint worked many miracles. **20-minute informal recital at the Abbey of Montecasino presented by St. Gregory the Great Parish Choir.** Independent lunch.

Carry on to visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Mentorella, located in the Prenestini mountains, is a spot that both Pope John Paul II and Benedict XVI traveled to around the time of being elected Pope. The shrine dates back to the time of Constantine the Great, and is one of the first Marian shrines in Italy. St. Benedict of Nursia founded the monastery a little over a century later. Pope John Paul II said, of Mentorella, "This is a place in which man opens to God in a special way. A place where, far from everything, but also at the same time close to nature, one can speak confidentially to God himself." Continue to Rome for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Rome.

**Day 8 March 16, Saturday: AM/St. Peter's Basilica – PM/Tour of Christian Rome – Evening Mass at the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls**

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning we have a special visit to St. Peter's Basilica, including a visit to the Grottos, (Papal Tombs), Library of the house of Canons and a presentation of the history of Cappella Giulia throughout five centuries. Independent lunch.

This afternoon, continue your day with a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the four major Basilicas built by Pope Sixtus III (AD 432-440). **Informal singing at the Basilica of St. Mary Major.** View the impressive interior with its remarkable mosaics in the nave depicting scenes from the Old Testament. View relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem and the high altar, which contains the remains of St. Matthew the Evangelist. The mosaics above the entablature are among the most ancient Christian mosaics in Rome. Continue to visit the Cathedral of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated. **Informal singing at the Cathedral of St. John Lateran.** It was founded by the Emperor Constantine in the 4th century and was home to the Popes for many years prior to the present Vatican residence. Then, proceed to visit the magnificent Basilica of St. Paul. It was built by Constantine in the 4th century on the site of St. Paul's tomb. After having been totally destroyed by fire in 1823, it was rebuilt on the original basilican plan of early Christian churches. Surrounding the nave are the medallions of each Pope, from Peter to Benedict XVI. **Celebrate the scheduled Mass at St. Paul's Basilica sung by St. Gregory the Great Parish Choir.**

Independent dinner.

Overnight at hotel in Rome. (B)

**Day 9 March 17, Sunday: AM/Solemn Mass at St. Peter's Basilica – PM/Formal Concert in Rome**

Leisurely breakfast at your hotel. **This morning you will be transferred to St. Peter's Basilica for the 10:30am Chapter Mass, in celebration of the Anniversary of Cappella Giulia, sung by the St. Gregory the Great Parish Choir and the Schola of Cappella Giulia.**

At noon attend the Papal Blessing in St. Peter's Square. Then, free time for independent lunch with the afternoon at leisure for browsing, shopping or exploring the sights of Rome. Hearty pilgrims may want to attempt to climb the 330 stairs (or take the elevator) to the top of St. Peter's for an unparalleled view of Vatican City and Rome.

Return to hotel to freshen-up.

**After early dinner, you will be transferred to the Church of Chiesa Nuova (Oratory of St. Philip Neri) for a rehearsal and formal concert presented by the St. Gregory the Great Parish Choir.**

Overnight at hotel in Rome. (B,D)

**Day 10 March 18, Monday: Return to the USA**

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Rome Leonardo da Vinci Airport for your return flight to the USA. Arrive home on the same day.

**PAYMENT:** Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check or money order only. In an effort to keep prices as low as possible, the package price reflects a cash discount. However, it is possible to make your final payment via MasterCard, Visa, Discover, or American Express. A \$100.00 convenience fee will apply to all packages paid by credit card. Invoices and credit card authorization forms will be included with your welcome document. The credit card form must be completed in entirety in order for the transaction to be approved. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase package rate or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. dollar in excess of 5% from print date. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will be required.

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** Round trip from Chicago O'Hare International Airport via US Airways. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Airfare is subject to increases prior to date of travel. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or double-bedded rooms with a cot or rollaway bed added. **Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an additional charge of \$750.00.** While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin rooms. We honestly do not like to assess an additional charge for the single traveler and will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancelling, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

**MEALS:** Buffet breakfast daily plus six (6) dinners as per attached itinerary. Beverages (coffee, tea, mineral water) are not included at set menu dinners.

**SIGHTSEEING AND ENTRANCE FEES:** All sightseeing as per itinerary aboard a private motorcoach with the services of a professional, licensed, English-speaking guide. Entrance fees to all sights are included.

**LAND ONLY PASSENGERS:** A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package (\$2,495.00 per person, sharing a twin room ) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. *Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the land only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. Additionally, if you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.*

**BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE:** Due to bus space, one carry-on bag and one checked bag per person are permitted. Standard airline baggage policies usually allow checked baggage up to 62 total inches and range to 50 pounds and carry-on baggage up to 45 total inches and up to 40 pounds. However, policies may vary from the time of printing of this brochure. Contact your airline directly before departure for current baggage dimension allowances. **TRANSFER AND PORTERAGE:** Round-trip private transfers from/to hotel. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels. We strongly suggest that you travel with one suitcase and one carry on.

Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference

**PASSENGERS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS:** The majority of our trips require a lot of walking, which may involve stairs, hills, cobblestone roads and uneven pavement. Additionally, most motor coaches are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. It is each passenger's responsibility to be aware of his or her limits with regard to travel and group activities. Any person with a disability requiring special attention must advise Peter's Way Tours of the situation at time of enrollment. A qualified companion must accompany any passenger requiring special assistance. Peter's Way Tours will make reasonable attempts to accommodate disabled passengers with special needs, but shall not be held responsible in the event we are unable to do so. Moreover, Peter's Way Tours is not responsible for the denial of services by any carriers, hotels, restaurants, or other independent suppliers.

**LATE RESERVATIONS:** A \$25.00 fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Reservations are subject to deadlines with airlines and various vendors. Special delivery charges incurred will also be due in advance.

**CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS:** From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, the cancellation fee will be \$350.00 per person.
